Master of Business Administration at the University of Tennessee. Dr. Kirton is board certified in Surgery and currently serves as the Chair of the Surgery Department at Abington - Jefferson Health.

Dr. Kirton has dedicated his life to teaching physicians of the future through his work at the University of Miami School of Medicine, Jackson Memorial Medical Center, University of Connecticut School of Medicine, and Hartford Hospital.

He is the author of several peer review publications and books and has been a guest lecturer at over 100 conferences.
